

Australian Kung Fu (Wu Shu) Federation Inc. Ordinary and Associate Membership Criteria

So authorised by the Committee to be effective from 1.7.10

The following membership categories shall be recognised:

1. Ordinary (Full Voting) Member
2. Associate Member

1. ORDINARY (FULL VOTING) MEMBER

Full Membership confers voting rights and shall be open to the person who is the President or nominee of the State or Territory Association that is the recognised body, by the AKWF, as the official governing body for Chinese martial arts (Kung Fu, Wushu, Tai Chi) in their respective State or Territory. The Ordinary member Association shall have signed a membership agreement with the AKWF.

2. ASSOCIATE MEMBER

Associate Membership does not confer voting rights and shall be open to the person who is the head of any national martial arts organisation that represents a style or system that is wholly or largely based on a Chinese martial art. Said organisation shall be a legally registered entity and shall enter into a binding membership agreement with the AKWF.

The Associate member must also be able to establish, to the Committee, a case for being accepted as a member of the National body as opposed to the relevant State Association.

An exception will be given to existing AKWF members who do not yet have an established representative State Association in their respective State or Territory or who have current matters before an AKWF Committee or Sub-Committee.
